Uniform

Following Covid-19, pupils, staff and parents guardians were surveyed about their preference for school uniform. The majority chose the option of allowing pupils to wear the school tracksuit on a daily basis. All children are obliged to wear the appropriate school tracksuit.

Pupils may choose to wear their existing school uniform if they so wish, but should not buy a replacement when their current uniform reaches its end of life. Another school tracksuit should be purchased at this time, as we recommend that all pupils have at least two school tracksuits.

For pupils, the school uniform, consisting of a light blue polo shirt, navy tracksuit bottoms or knee length school shorts, the same fabric as their tracksuit bottoms, and a navy tracksuit top with the school crest sewn on, should be worn.

Earrings, if worn, should be small studs. For health and safety reasons, no hoop / dangly earrings should be worn.

Long hair, below shoulder length, should be tied up at all times.

Dark runners should be worn to school. Please do not wear black-soled runners please as they mark floor surfaces.

Parents are asked to label relevant items of clothing with their child's name and make contact with the school if an item of clothing is missing. Lost and found property is located on the top corridor of the school.
